

# LineSight Ops - Inspection Accountability Setup

A focused guided setup for one recurring inspection workflow: required, completed, failed, and follow-up visibility.

## What this is

A practical guided setup for teams that need a cleaner inspection accountability chain without buying a broad EHS suite or starting an enterprise rollout. It starts with one recurring workflow and proves whether the process creates better field and supervisor visibility.

## Best-fit operations

- Construction, sitework, utilities, warehouse, yard, material handling, rental, and field operations.
- Teams using paper, spreadsheets, texts, or verbal follow-up for required inspections.
- Supervisors who need a cleaner answer to what was completed, missed, failed, and followed up.

Not the right first step for teams expecting a legal/compliance guarantee, a broad EHS suite, or every workflow/integration solved before the first path is proven.

## Starting offer

**Inspection Accountability Setup:** typically **\$750-\$1,500** depending on workflow complexity, assets/locations/users, and handoff needs.

Included setup component
Existing checklist/process review
One recurring inspection workflow configured as the starting path
Assets, locations, and users scoped for the first workflow
Field completion path with Pass / Fail / N/A style results
Supervisor review path for failed items and follow-up visibility
Handoff guide with next-step recommendations

## Workflow accountability chain

Step	What it proves
Field check	Worker completes the required checklist.

Failed item	Issue is preserved instead of disappearing.
Supervisor review	Follow-up becomes visible and actionable.
Manager snapshot	Leadership can see process health.

## Guided setup process

- Confirm the recurring workflow and operating environment.
- Review the existing checklist, asset list, user roles, and location structure.
- Configure the starter workflow and field path.
- Verify failed-item visibility in Supervisor Review.
- Review handoff notes and decide whether to expand.

## Expansion path

After the first workflow proves useful, expansion can include reporting, hosted/backend persistence, additional workflows, integrations, offline/local deployment scoping, or a broader Workflow Diagnostic.

## Caveats

- Offline-capable or customer-hosted deployment can be scoped, but should not be assumed for every operation.
- This supports inspection accountability and recordkeeping; it is not legal advice or a compliance guarantee.
